## FORMAL OPENING:

at 13 o'clock. 16<sup>th</sup> April 2005

## EVALUATION:

at 15 o'clock 16<sup>th</sup> April 2005

Evaluation is carried out by recognised model-makers from five different countries. The groups of three members highlight the best works of the given category jointly. In categories with lots of models the members of the jury score the highlighted models independently of each other. The final order is settled after summing up the scores. In the categories where there are a lot of models of high level, more identical places can be given. Occasionally the "I like it" or "I don't like it" evaluating system can be used (if there are few models in the given category).

The members of the jury take the models into their hands, of course with gloves, only for good cause.

The highlighted models that are not placed because of the great number of models in the category are awarded by the "Especially nice model of high-level" certificates acknowledging the work of the model-maker. These are placed next to the models. The yellow boards having the note "AWARDED MODEL/DÍJAZOTT MUNKÁ" on them are placed next to the models that are placed. We ask for documentation only in special cases (special painting, rebuilding etc.).

## THE HIGHLIGHTED CATEGORIES OF OUR NEXT SHOW AND COMPETITION:

- Members of P-47 family
- Land instruments and vehicles of the World War II on the African seat of operations
- Figure: famous persons' (politicians, actors, film stars, sportsmen, sportswomen) lifelike portraits
- It happened 50 years ago. It is devoted to the memory of the Hungarian Revolution and War of Independence in 1956. (If it is possible we are asking for documentation.)

## CHALLENGE-CUP:

Our club has joined the special competition established by the model club in Koprivnice, Czech Republic, which with a challenge-cup of each announced category wish to commemorate joining the European Union in 2004. The challenge-cup tours one yearly competition of the joined countries. Of course, who wins it three times can definitely obtain one of the impressive cups. Besides the club in the founder country the following clubs have joined the competition: Poprád (Slovakia), Cieszyn (Poland), Twenot (The Netherlands), Mosonmagyaróvár (Hungary). In this special competition the evaluation is done by a special jury, which consists of the members from the joined counties, by scoring. Of course, model-makers from all countries can enter for this competition. The intention of entering should be indicated on the entry form.

## The announced categories of this competition:

In highlighted and EU categories the models entered for previous competitions in Mosonmagyaróvár can also take part.

The best exhibition stand is awarded specially by the votes of visitors and model-makers. (The exhibition area has become much larger so we can provide good possibilities for every exhibitor.)

## INFORMATION:

### 16<sup>th</sup> April 2005 (Saturday)

- As last year, in 2005 we are also organising the International Indoor Football Championship of Model Clubs. (Teams consist of 5 players and 1 goalkeeper and the playing time is 15 minutes.) We are awaiting entries of ad hoc and friendly teams as well. (In 2004 the team of Sponsors was the winner. (It was not a rigged match!))
- We are again organising the weight-lifting championship for winning "The strongest model-maker" title. (In 2004 Kovács Csaba was the winner with the record of 25 kilograms.) The qualifying limit is 5 kilograms. (You should not be frightened.)
- In 2005 we also await everybody interested in our usual programmes: archery, table tennis, boat-trip, and a short bicycle ride.
- We are planning an excursion to visit the palace in Hédervár (20 kms), which is the most beautiful palace in our region. As a technical interest, the weir in Dunakiliti (15 km) can also be seen.
- We are going to show the sights of or town to those interested (a short horse coach ride, museum visit).
- We are also planning a bus trip to the barracks of the 12<sup>th</sup> Anti-aircraft Rocket Brigade in Győr (40 kms).
- During the evaluation the exhibition stands can be visited.
- In the evening hours all our model-making friends and the members of their families are invited to a dinner.

### 17<sup>th</sup> April 2005 (Sunday)

On the place of the competition a lot of sights and other interesting things entertain the visitors, among them film show, show modelling, performance of tradition-keeping groups (from ancient times until now). Of course the popular dance show is to be held as well.

## OTHER INFORMATION:

- Models are given back after the announcement of results (at about 15 o'clock on 17<sup>th</sup> April 2005). We kindly ask everybody to honour show and visitors with not packing his/her works before the official ceremony. On order to receive your works back please hold your counterfoil and show it on request.
- On Saturday and Sunday *Varga Gábor*, member of the Pirát Model Club in Balatonalmádi and *Pákozdi Péter*, member of the Fabricate Model Club in Gárdony have a photo exhibition.
- A selection from the photos about the World War II taken by *Karay Sándor*, a former war correspondent.
- Some relics from the Hungarian areas of World War II can be seen.
- We commemorate the lives of hussars in a small exhibition in the Hanság Museum.
- An exhibition and market of the certified copies of historic miniatures, original weapons and armours with the help of Budavári Shop.
- Courageous and enterprising visitors can fight with the pilots of the Hungarian Airforce with the help of the simulator game of JETFLY.
- The history of technology in small stamps.
- During the exhibition and competition *Miklós János's* match-castle collection showing the Hungarian castles from the 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> centuries can be visited.
- Against tiredness you can have a little rest by browsing the modelling journals of different countries in the library of the club.
- A selection from *Paksi Konstantin's* unique car collection can be seen.
- Our guests can also visit the metal cars, engines and lorries of our friend, *Weres Zoltán*, from Győr.
- A selection from *Szítás István's* special medal collection.

As for our club, we can accept bookings at student hostels or in private houses on the basis of the received demands.

(two double rooms with a separate bathroom and toilet belonging to them, breakfast is not included)

**Student hostel II.** 1,800 HUF per person per night  
(two double rooms, a shared bathroom and toilet at the end of the corridor, breakfast is not included)

**Student hostel III.** 1,500 HUF per person per night  
(rooms for four persons, a shared bathroom and toilet at the end of corridor, breakfast is not included)

### Rooms to let in private houses

They are of different quality, simple but clean and comfortable.  
(2,000 HUF per person per night plus breakfast between 400 and 600 HUF)

Accommodation at student hostels II. and III. is quite simple!

- Those coming from the direction of Hegyeshalom (Vienna) or Rajka (Bratislava) do not have to buy vignettes for the motorway up to Mosonmagyaróvár.

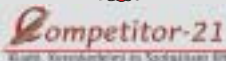
